RE: Options Process Year 9

We are delighted to invite you to our annual options evening where staff will be available to discuss their courses for Y10/Y11. This will take place on Wednesday 6th March with a 5pm start. Students in Forms MP and MW should attend from 5pm and students from PA, HL and MB should attend from 5.30pm. Having a staggered entry should help with overcrowding in classrooms. This will be an opportunity to speak to Option Subject staff about what the GCSE courses entail and look at the types of work students do as well as the resources we use.

I would like students to submit their Option Choices to me by Wednesday 20th March using the Microsoft form link that will be sent to all Year 9 students through their Edulink account. They will need to put choices in preference order and include reserve choices. I will always do my best to give students their 3 options of choice but usually do have to use some reserves as well. This is purely down to what is the best fitting mathematical model and I use a computer programme to do this. No option choices are based on anything but what is the best fit for all.
