Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for completing and returning the form providing us with essential information about your child who is joining our school in September. We are now using this information in making preparations for the start of the new school year. I hope we will be able to work together so that they can grow towards adulthood in the most favourable and helpful circumstances. Co-operation between school and home is vital at all stages of a child's education but especially so when a fresh start is being made in a new school.

To ease this transition, we have arranged for all new students entering Year 7 to spend a day in school on **Tuesday 4th July 2023**. On this day your child should wear their current school uniform and be brought to the High School for **8.45am** where they will be met at the gates by current pupils who will escort them into school. They will be assigned to one of five tutor groups and will follow a fairly normal timetable so it will be useful for them to bring a pencil case. All Year 6 pupils on this day will be provided with a free school meal, however they may wish to purchase items at break time which cost from 30p for a slice of toast. Your child will be excused from the school at **3.00pm**. On the evening of **Tuesday 4th July** we look forward to seeing parents in school at **6.00pm**. This evening is for **parents only**. There will be the opportunity to meet your child's form tutor and the Head of Transition who is also Year Leader of Year 7 and to follow up any matters that have arisen during the day, we would especially welcome any feedback you may wish to give us. The new school term for Year 7 will begin on Tuesday 5th September.

The current School Dress Code is available on the school's website which you will find under Pastoral Support and you will be given an up-to-date version on 4th July. The essentials for your child are dark navy straight legged regulation school trousers or a dark navy knee length regulation school skirt, white/navy school polo shirt (with school logo or plain), navy school sweatshirt (all available online from Price and Buckland) and plain PVC or leather flat black shoes. I look forward to welcoming you to the school.
