We recognise that students in receipt of Pupil Premium funding are not a homogenous group and may require varying levels and types of support throughout their time with us. The following offer outlines the support available (for further information, please see our Pupil Premium Strategy):

Pupil Premium

- High-quality teaching delivered by specialist subject teachers, supported by ongoing CPD focused on evidence-based strategies
- Teachers and support staff know pupils well and plan for challenge, with appropriate adaptation and intervention to meet individual needs
- Targeted academic support, including reading and maths interventions
- Access to Curriculum Support sessions, providing a focused working environment with staff support
- Supervised study opportunities before and after school, as well as during social times
- Tutor Reading programme to support literacy development
- Strong pastoral support, including 1:1 and group provision to support emotional wellbeing
- A consistent approach to attendance, including first-day calling, monitoring, and support for families
- Access to a wide range of enrichment opportunities to support personal development and broaden experiences

Pupil Premium: Entitled to Targeted Free School Meals

- Access to a funded uniform package at key transition points (Years 7 and 9)
- Support to ensure a positive start to the school day, including access to breakfast provision
- Provision of recommended resources across the curriculum, including stationery packs, calculators, food ingredients, and KS4 revision guides; laptops may also be provided to support learning at home where appropriate
- Access to fully funded extracurricular opportunities, including day trips, sports, and peripatetic music tuition, with financial support of up to £500 towards one UK residential visit and up to £750 towards one international residential visit.

This offer is designed to remove barriers to learning, ensure equity of access, and enable all students to thrive both academically and personally.
