Dear Year 11,

In the current circumstances you have faced a great deal of uncertainty with regards to the GCSE process. Hopefully the following information will help you to feel more comfortable about GCSE Results Day. As you will know, the school has to put safety at the forefront and therefore the results day process will be completely different to previous years. It will not be possible to have groups of students meeting at school to receive their results. I understand that this will be very disappointing for many of you as the sharing of the experience, the congratulating, the support and having someone on hand to give advice is important. We too will miss the opportunity to share the experience as the culmination of all of your tremendous efforts.

In order that the results are distributed promptly to all students at once they will be released through Edulink at 8:30am on Thursday 20th August. In your Edulink home page there is an exam icon. On entering this section there are three headings, one of which is 'Exam Results'. The results are embargoed and will therefore not appear until 8:30am and so at the moment, for most people, it is blank. If you have received a grade for a Child Development module you will be able to see those now as the release date for those has passed.

The grades will also be posted home on Wednesday 19th August. It is not possible to know whether these would arrive by Thursday's post hence the Edulink release as well. Please ensure that the school has an up to date postal address for us to send the results. If you are aware that a friend may not have received this message, could we please ask you to share this information.

Support on the day will be available. If you have a concern about any of your result please email the school on the following dedicated email address. You may wish to speak with somebody regarding the result itself, how your results affect your application to the Joint Sixth Form: whether you are unsure of your place, your subject choices or wish to make a fresh application. Staff will be dealing with any queries and responding throughout the day. gcseresultqueries@beverleyhigh.net

If you have concerns about the grade that you have been awarded the appeals process has changed considerably. Ofqual have stated that appeals on the grounds of an admin error and as a result of receiving the wrong grade are possible. Should you disagree with the grade awarded to you then you would be entitled to sit the planned GCSE exams to be held in approximately November. More details of the process will be included with your results.

In addition, you may be interested to know that on Friday 10 July at 10am, the Prime Minister will be giving an address to all school leavers which will be broadcast on [Facebook](#) and [YouTube](#).
