Dear Parents, Carers and Students

I hope that this letter finds you safe and well.

Following my letter of 11 May 2020 schools in England have been issued with some guidance from the government about reopening to a wider cohort of students providing that the 5 key tests set by the government are met. We are expecting further guidance to be published this week.

Schools will be asked to open to students in Years 10 and 12 to offer some face to face contact with teachers to supplement the remote learning of Years 10 and 12, alongside those pupils who have already been attending as priority groups.

Obviously, there is a vast amount of planning and preparation that needs to take place to ensure that, when we increase the number of pupils in school, there are routines to ensure that social distancing can take place.

To enable us to plan for the return of these year groups, I ask that parents of Year 10 and 12 students complete the one question survey <https://go.beverleyhigh.net/parentsurvey1> to let me know whether you intend to send your child back to school in the summer term. Please note it is unlikely that the school will be in a position to open to more pupils in week beginning 1 June. We will communicate the precise details of what the contact will look like when the logistics have been worked through.

As a parent of a child eligible to return to school in the summer term myself, I am sure that you will have lots of questions! I hope that many of them will be answered by the link below (for example, is it compulsory to send my child to school?)
