Dear Parent/ Carer,

Now that pupils are settling back into the routine of school many parents will be keen to know how your child is doing. The challenges of on-line learning followed by re-integration to the classroom require a short transition period for pupils and staff. The initial focus being re-establishing a good approach to learning in the classroom environment and balancing this with managing the anxiety many youngsters will be feeling at this time. Therefore, independent learning and formal assessments have been avoided until Easter.

Looking forward, our proposed plan for reporting and parents' evenings for Years 7 through to 10 is as follows. The Year 10 pupils have not yet received a report this year and will therefore be first in the new reporting schedule. To allow suitable assessment opportunities the collation of reports will begin after the first two weeks of the summer term. The reports will be available in Edulink from the following dates. An alert will be sent to inform you they have been published.

Year 10 reports:	6 th May
Year 7, 8 & 9 reports:	20 th May
Year 7 parents' evening:	14 th June
Year 8 parents' evening:	15 th June
Year 9 parents' evening:	16 th June
Year 10 parents evening:	15 th July
Year 7, 8 & 9 reports:	22 nd July

Although optimism is our preference, please be advised that these dates are subject to change should it be necessary.

Parents' evenings for Key Stage 3 will be taken by tutors through on-line meetings. Year 10 will have subject specific meetings. We have successfully trialled a system for delivering these appointments and will give you the details nearer the time. The tutor will talk through the reports briefly and provide a summary of achievement, attitude towards learning and pastoral issues.

There will be a Year 10 assessment period from the beginning 21st June through to 7th July. All assessments will be classroom based and may involve writing tasks of approximately 20 minutes or short tests of a maximum of 40 minutes to allow for pupils with extra time allowance. Some guidance of the schedule will be available nearer the time. Each department will inform pupils what they intend to assess and how this will be done with suitable notice.
