Dear parent / carer

I hope this letter finds you safe and well.

I am writing to you following new guidance received regarding the Government's plan for 'living with COVID'.

Although free COVID-19 tests will continue to be available for specific groups, including eligible patients and NHS staff, the universal testing offer has ended for most of the population. We do not have any boxes of lateral flow tests left and are no longer able to order any more. We have also been advised that we are unable to pass any other testing equipment to staff, students, or families at this time.

Updated guidance advises:

- adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days

I strongly advise you to follow this advice and keep your child at home if they are unwell.

This has been a long road and I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your understanding and patience during the last two years. Every single one of the decisions made in school has been made to keep all staff, pupils and their wider families as safe as possible.
