Dear Parents/Carers and Students

I hope that this letter finds you safe and well.

Following my letter of Friday 5 June 2020 I am writing with more details of the telephone calls that Year 7, 8 and 9 tutors will be making to their tutees from next week to check on progress and wellbeing.

For the most part tutors will call on:

Year 7 - Tuesday 23 June
Year 8 - Tuesday 30 June
Year 9 - Tuesday 7 July

Some calls may be from a withheld number, if you would like your child to speak with their tutor please accept the call.

I am conscious that on the school system most of the primary contact telephone numbers we have are parents' mobile numbers and you may now have returned to work. If you would like your child's tutor to call a specific number please can you text or email office@beverleyhigh.net to let us know your preferred number?

The DfE has instructed schools that, "We are unable to welcome back more children to secondary school at this time, beyond the face-to-face support schools can now offer year 10 and 12 pupils, and provision for vulnerable children and children of critical workers. We are not asking secondary schools to invite further year groups to return this term."

However, on Monday of this week, the government announced that schools will be able to offer face-to-face meetings before the end of this term for students in other year groups where it would be beneficial. This would be an individual pastoral support meeting for any child who has found their experience of the pandemic/lockdown particularly challenging. If you feel that your child would benefit from a 1:1 meeting of this nature please email office@beverleyhigh.net. Such meetings would be of one hour duration and would be scheduled on a Friday.

During next week, Mr Colton will be uploading work for the last four weeks of the summer term.

When we are informed by government about what September will look like we will of course share our plans with you. Until then take care and stay safe.
