Re: School uniform

The presentation of uniform is something upon which the school prides itself and standards are high. We would like to thank both pupils and parents for your co-operation and inform you of some recent updates with regard to school uniform.

There has been a tendency for pupils to “roll up” the current skirt to amend the style. This means that the skirt becomes much shorter and tighter than the intended design and can cause the zip to break. In order to resolve this issue, there have been some amendments to the school dress code for pupils. From Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018, the straight style skirt will no longer be available to purchase (any skirts ordered prior to this date will still be available to collect). The school regulation skirt is a now a pleated style skirt for all year groups. There is no requirement for parents to buy a new skirt unless this item needs replacing.

From Monday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018, pupils who choose to continue to wear the straight skirt but “roll up” their skirt to make it shorter, or otherwise try to amend the design of the uniform, will be issued with a sanction, this is likely to involve the loss of social time.

Should pupils arrive at school wearing incorrect uniform then they may be offered uniform loaned to them by the school or issued with a sanction. Please help us to avoid this by ensuring that your daughter is dressed in the correct uniform. You will receive a further update letter at the end of the school year.

School skirts should be worn at the correct length. Rolling up the waist is inappropriate and could cause damage to the zip. Trousers can be purchased from either the Beverley Music Centre or from Marks and Spencer online.

- ◆ Shoes — flat plain black in leather or PVC (for health and safety reasons)
- ◆ Socks — plain white, navy or black (ankle or knee length ) **or** Tights — plain navy or black (opaque or sheer)
- ◆ Coat — appropriate for school and weather conditions (no zipped hoodies)

### **PE kit**

Essential A pale blue polo shirt bearing the school logo

Navy shorts (suitable for gym & dance)

Trainers with non marking soles (no canvas shoes or pumps)

Optional Plain navy tracksuit bottoms

Outdoor top, without hood, for cold weather

Hockey/football boots with plastic or rubber studs

Pale blue hockey socks, shin pads, gum shield

### **Students may also wear.....**

- ◆ 1 pair of stud earrings or small hoops
- ◆ 1 ring
- ◆ 1 watch

### **Students must not wear.....**

- ◆ Boots (including ankle boots and shoes/ boots that cover the ankle) or canvas shoes
- ◆ Hoodies of any kind
- ◆ Hair accessories (subtle bobbles/hair ties in school colours are permitted)
- ◆ Leggings, over the knee socks or socks over the top of tights
- ◆ Extremes of fashion and hairstyle including unnatural hair colours
- ◆ Make up
- ◆ Coloured nail varnish (including natural/nude colours) - nails must be short in length
- ◆ Any form of facial or oral piercing e.g. nose studs, tongue studs or retainers
- ◆ Sunglasses
- ◆ Bracelets

**Valuable jewellery should not be worn to school and all jewellery should be removed for PE. Inappropriate items will be placed in an envelope and will be available for collection at the end of the school day. Pupils who choose not to comply will be spoken to and an appropriate sanction will be put in place**
