



Dear Parent/Carer

We know that choosing your child's secondary school is a hugely important decision.

In reaching the right decision for your daughter you will want to be as fully informed as possible. To that end, you will need information about our most recent examination results.

In August 2019 Beverley High School students celebrated an outstanding set of GCSE results across the board with particularly impressive results in the new style of academic GCSEs.

- Progress 8 (Provisional) is 0.51 which places the school as “well above average”
- 77% of students achieved the new 9-4 measure in English and Maths which is broadly similar to the old A*-C measure
- For the new “strong” pass – grades 5 and above - 49% of students reached this threshold which is expected to be well above the National Average.
- This year was the second year of the new grade 9 at GCSE which is designed to identify the very highest achievement. Over 7% of grades were grade 9 compared with 2.5% nationally. There were some extraordinary results across subjects including 11% Grade 9 in English Literature, 16 % Grade 9 in Biology, 14% in Chemistry and Physics, 33% in Music and 19% in Geography. Truly phenomenal!

Our EBacc results were also exceptional, with 52% of students achieving Grades 4-9 in English, Maths, Science, Modern Languages, History or Geography.

There had been a huge amount of uncertainty across the country with the introduction of the new GCSEs in English and Maths. We are absolutely delighted with how well our students have performed right across the school. It is fabulous that 77% have achieved the “standard pass” in English and Maths. These results continue the trend of outstanding performance by our students at GCSE over many years.

We are also thrilled that so many students have achieved the new grade 9. The new grade was designed to identify the very highest levels of achievement and for our students to be so far ahead of national averages is a real testament to their hard work and the commitment of our staff. The progress that students of all abilities have made is excellent and we expect to be around the top 10% of schools for the new benchmark Progress 8. We are very proud of every one of our Year 11 students.

At A Level the Joint Sixth we have with Beverley Grammar School is also thriving with 59% of students gaining Grades A*-B and 82% achieving Grades A*-C. Around 40% of the entrants to University are attending Russell Group Universities including 5 to Medicine and 1 to Cambridge – again an outstanding achievement.
